Ms. Jeter-Cutting's social work career has also included employment at Provident Hospital, Baltimore City Health Department and Deaton Chronic Care Medical Center. She has completed field placements at the Attorney General's Office-Mediation Unit and the Baltimore City Community Mediation Program. All areas of employment have exposed her to a variety of social, economical and cultural concerns that have encouraged her to continue promoting empowerment and social justice.
